IAA News: Optimisation instead of hectic rush

PTV AG at IAA Commercial Vehicles 2010

Karlsruhe, Germany, September 1, 2010. PTV will be presenting software systems with numerous new features for route and transport planning, including truck navigation, at this year's IAA Commercial Vehicles, in hall 24, stand F13.

Avoiding detours thanks to truck navigation

In order to easily find the optimum route, the maps of the new truck navigator 6 now include a lot more information on truck restrictions, such as clearance height and weight, no through roads and hazardous goods as well as alerts to sharp turns, and steep uphill and downhill roads. Realistic junction views and motorway signposts, and an interface which allows "buddies" to be displayed on the map are further innovative features. Drivers can now easily see the current position of the vehicles belonging to their own fleet in order to arrange a meeting or convoy driving.

Economical and eco-friendly driving

map&guide professional 2010 assists users in planning efficient trips and routes. Thanks to a connection to Teleroute's freight exchange, dispatchers who still have space available for additional cargo, can access Teleroute data directly from the software. On Teleroute's platform they can choose from 200,000 freight and vehicle offers each day. Integrated emission reporting allows users to provide a route-based carbon emissions certificate for each transport. It is the first emissions calculation that has been certified by an independent body - it now bears the seal of approval by TÜV Süd. After calculating the emissions, users can offset them by means of climate certificates.

Optimised route and vehicle scheduling

The new PTV Intertour release provides Europe's fastest routing which enables users to speed up internal processes. Moreover, the new Workload Balancing feature ensures that trips and routes are assigned to drivers in a fair manner. And an integrated CO₂ emissions calculator provides evidence of environmentally friendly logistics.

The future belongs to intelligent freight transport

A study conducted by PTV on behalf of the European Commission shows what transport systems will be like in the future. The latest results will be presented to the general public for the first time at IAA Commercial Vehicles on September 27. Experts from politics, research and business will provide up-to-date information on intelligent freight systems.
